

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS & PUPILS AUTUMN TERM (COVID-19)

During these uncertain times it falls to all of us to ensure the safety of everyone and to try and stop the spread of the virus. With this, 2 metre Social Distancing and the most recent Government Guidelines we need to put in place a variety of changes when coming to classes and these must be followed. Full details are in our **Risk Assessment** but in brief:

1. **NO PARENT** (or other Family member) is permitted inside any part of the venues where the classes are held. This is a requirement of the venues and must be followed. Pupils may be taken to the main entrance or may walk to the entrance from their parked car. All Parents are to ensure that they follow 2 metre social distancing if dropping off.
2. Parents, Family members and/or Friends are **NOT** permitted to use any of the facilities inside any of the venues.
3. Pupils must come with as few bags as possible and will need to change for class and do their hair in the car **before** they enter the venue. To try and make this easier we are happy for the Children coming straight from school to have a pony tail if there is not sufficient time for a bun.
3. There are no changing facilities at the venues at this present time. Although we would prefer the pupils in the correct uniform, if this will cause you to be delayed for class then please wear anything suitable.
4. Pupils must also bring their own drink & snacks as there are no cups at the hall or any form of refreshments.
5. There will be a one-way system in place which will be explained on arrival. Every pupil will be required to wash their hands in warm, soapy water before AND after each class. Hand sanitizer will also be available.
6. We are requesting 'no bare feet' so pupils will need to use old ballet shoes or jazz shoes for those cases where they do not usually have any foot ware.
7. Between classes, any above floor items possibly touched will be sanitised. There is a 15 minute gap between each class to ensure we have a safe entry and exit to and from the studios.
8. Windows will be opened for ventilation and main doors will be left open to lessen the touch points.
9. At the end of their class a staff member will bring the pupils to the Car Park for collection. Please remember safe distancing.
10. If a pupil has one class following another then they may stay in the Studio. If a pupil has a class following, but not the next class, then they should leave the class with other pupils and go back to their Parent/Guardian in the Car Park.
11. If anyone has Covid symptoms you must stay away from the venues. If you have Covid symptoms and have attended a venue then we must be informed immediately. Random temperature test will be taking place.

We completely understand that all this very austere **BUT** it is the only way that we are **permitted** to return to normal classes and it is ultimately for the **safety** of everyone. Roshe are instigating the 2 metre social distancing, keeping pupils apart and limiting numbers so as to avoid compromising their **Educational School Bubbles**. If your child attends other after school activities and they **do not** have a Risk Assessment or correct Social-Distancing rules in place then maybe you should ask them why! We are sure that we will all get used to this '**new**' normal but let us hope that soon we can get back to the '**old**' normal.
